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**PROGRESSING INTO OTHER AREAS OF MANUFACTURING  
Natoli Delivers a New Training Course: Hard Shell Encapsulation**

The new three-day course will take place on July 22-24, 2008 at Natoli's technical training center in St. Charles MO. Created for individual's involved with capsule manufacturing; this course will covers issues with capsule pellets, powders, liquids, formulation modifiers, ingredients, blending, specialized fill, micro-dosing blind studies and the challenges of scale up and running filling equipment.

As Natoli continues to develop the most influential tablet compression training center in the United States, their training center's curriculum has progressed into other areas of manufacturing.
